Who is eligible for the flu vaccine this year?

- pregnant women
- 2- and 3-year-olds (age on 31 August 2026)
- school aged children (from reception to year 11)
- people aged 65 and over
- people with certain long term health conditions, from 6 months to under 65s
- people living with somebody with a weakened immune system due to a medical condition or treatment
- people sleeping rough or in hostels/shelters
- care home residents
- carers (receiving carer's allowance, or the main carer of an older or disabled person)
- frontline health and social care workers

Speak to your local GP practice, pharmacist or maternity service if you're not sure if you're eligible.
