

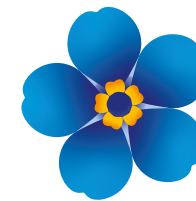

Dementia Advice and Support Service

Alzheimer's Society are commissioned by Durham County Council to deliver the Dementia Advice & Support Service in County Durham. We support people over 18 and living in County Durham who are worried about their memory, have a diagnosis of dementia and carers, families, and friends.

People can access the service at any point in their journey, as many times as they need. The Dementia Adviser will work with people through the diagnosis process, following a diagnosis and throughout their journey, listening to people's needs and offering tailored information and advice so they can consider future options.

Young Onset, Veteran and Prison Dementia Support

Alongside the Dementia Advice and Support Service we can also provide: A Young Onset Dementia Adviser, supporting people diagnosed under the age of 65 and their carers. The Dementia Adviser also facilitates a Young Onset Dementia Voice Group.

A Veterans Dementia Adviser, supporting people living with dementia and their carers who have served in the Armed Forces.

A Prison Dementia Adviser, supporting people living with dementia who are living, or working, within a County Durham prison.
