CQC Update: Medwyn Surgery Rated Outstanding Again

Medwyn Surgery has once again been rated Outstanding overall by the Care Quality Commission (CQC) following a routine inspection in September, making this the second time the practice has achieved the highest possible rating. Only around 5% of GP practices in England are rated Outstanding. The CQC rated Medwyn as Outstanding for Caring, Responsive and Well-Led, and Good for Safe and Effective, praising the practice's leadership, patient care and commitment to reducing health inequalities. Inspectors highlighted strong patient feedback, excellent access by phone, high satisfaction levels, and the positive impact of community initiatives such as the Medwyn Carers Network, Men's Shed and MASH, alongside a clear focus on staff wellbeing and continuous improvement.

Reflecting on the rating, Dr Stewart Tomlinson said:

"We are incredibly proud to have been rated Outstanding by the CQC for the second time. This achievement reflects the dedication, compassion, and professionalism of every member of our team.

At Medwyn, we've always believed that excellent care goes beyond the consultation room. It's about knowing our community, listening to our patients, and continuously finding better ways to support their health and wellbeing. We are deeply grateful to our patients for their trust and to our staff for their unwavering commitment to making Medwyn a place where everyone feels valued and cared for."

Flu Vaccination Clinics

Flu season is upon us and protecting yourself and those around you is more important than ever. We are pleased to be offering free NHS flu vaccinations again this year for eligible patients. Please contact the surgery if you are eligible and have not yet had your vaccination.

Who is eligible?

You are entitled to a free NHS flu vaccine if you are:

- Aged 65 years and over (including those who turn 65 before 31 March 2026)
- Pregnant
- Aged 6 months to under 65 years with certain long-term health conditions (such as heart disease, lung disease including asthma, diabetes, kidney disease, liver disease, or weakened immunity)
- Children aged 2 or 3 years on 31 August 2025
- All primary school-aged children (vaccinations usually delivered through schools)
- Carers who receive a carer's allowance or are the main carer for an older or disabled person
- People living with someone who is more likely to get severe illness from flu (for example, those with a weakened immune system)
- Frontline health or social care workers.

COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics

Free NHS COVID-19 vaccinations are being offered to those most at risk of serious illness. This includes adults aged **75 years and over, residents in care homes for older adults**, and **individuals who are immunosuppressed aged 6 months and over**. Vaccination remains an important way of reducing the risk of severe illness and hospital admission. Please contact the surgery if you are eligible and have not yet had your vaccination.









Crisis Support for the Festive Season

Although the festive period is a time of celebration for many, it can also be a difficult and isolating time if you are struggling with your mental wellbeing. Feelings of low mood or anxiety can make it harder to enjoy the season, and the pressures often associated with Christmas and the New Year can feel overwhelming.
