Dear homeowner or occupier,

As part of Surrey County Council's commitment to improving roads and pavements, safety works will be commencing on Heathside Road & White Rose Lane, Woking.

From 10 November for 3 weeks:

- **Heathside Road will be under a 24/7 closure from outside The Woking Clinic to outside no 23a.**
- **White Rose Lane will be under two-way signals from the junction with Heathside Crescent to 100m south of the junction with Heathside Road.**

From 1 December for 1 week:

- **Heathside Road will be under a 24/7 closure from outside The Woking Clinic to outside no 23a.**
- **White Rose Lane will be under a 24/7 closure from the junction with Heathside Crescent to 100m south of the junction with Heathside Road.**

From 8 December for 2 weeks

- **White Rose Lane will be under a 24/7 closure from the junction with Heathside Road to the junction with Old Woking Road. This will be a rolling closure over the 2 weeks so access can still be maintained.**

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – they are keen to deliver the work with minimal disruption to you.

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles to enable the work to proceed as planned.

The work is weather dependant and can be delayed by bad weather or other factors. Please look at our information boards on site for date changes.

We thank you for your patience while we carry out these works and apologise for any inconvenience caused.
