Our GP practices are now part of a national initiative to offer NHS lung cancer screening.

You will be invited to have a lung health check if you are **registered with one of our GP practices**, aged between **55 and 74** and either **smoke or have ever smoked** in the past.

People will **automatically be invited** to take part when the screening service reaches their area.

If you receive a lung cancer screening invitation in the post, don't ignore it. Please take part.

Lung cancer screening is designed to **save more lives by finding problems early** when a treatment could be simpler and more successful.

Those aged 55 to 74 who are current or former smokers will be invited to a lung health check.

The Lung Cancer Screening journey

You'll receive a letter in the post in a yellow envelope.



A phone call or meeting with a health professional will be arranged to discuss your breathing, overall lung health, lifestyle and family and medical history.



If required, you'll be invited to have a quick and painless low dose CT scan of your lungs



Once we have your results you'll be given the all clear or referred on for treatment.
