Like many GP practices across the UK, we are unable to accept all private letter requests.

GPs are facing increasing workload pressures, including a growing number of requests from third parties.

Under the terms of the NHS GP contract, they are not obligated to fulfil private letter requests, nor is additional time allocated for private work. As a result, such requests are always at the GP's discretion and will incur a charge as listed below.

All fees are chargeable in advance.

Only cash or cheque can be accepted, cheques made payable to ***Chertsey Health Centre***

**Private Work/letters that will be considered are listed below:-**

**Certificates & letters**

Private Sick Note	<b>£30</b>
Private Prescription (including for travel)	<b>£30</b>
Holiday cancellation certificate	<b>£50</b>
Letter to fly with medication	<b>£30</b>
Fitness to travel examination with report	<b>£130</b>
To Whom It May Concern Letter	<b>£30</b>

**Forms**

Power of Attorney	<b>£140 + £90 if home visit needed</b>
Medical insurance claim form	<b>£70</b>
Holiday Cancellation Form	<b>£50</b>
OFSTED Child-minder form	<b>£100</b> Payment in advance
Medical Health Questionnaire	<b>£40</b>

**Medical Examinations**

Private consultation (10 minute appointment)	<b>£100</b>
Pre-Employment /Taxi Driver/HGV/Adoption/LGV /PCV/Racing Driver	
With/Without full medical (Elderly drivers at Doctors discretion)	<b>£140</b>
Medical examinations	<b>£140</b>
Capacity Assessments	<b>£160</b>

**Private letters we are NOT able to provide:-**

1. Letters for nurseries/schools/universities
2. Fit to Fly letters including during pregnancy
3. Letters regarding gym membership
4. Letters/forms declaring fitness for sporting/fitness events
5. Benefit appeal letters - they should be directed to the relevant authorities (e.g., Jobcentre Plus) and understand that the GP's refusal will not automatically affect the claim.
