4. Practice Updates	 Currently looking to work with other practices to align services. Now have two GP's to triage on a Monday to manage demand. Start of October triage forms will be open for the majority of surgery hours. Nursing appointments we now have majority of appointments within 2 weeks, used to be up to 6 weeks. COVID vaccinations are finished within the surgery for spring, you can still book on the national system up to 17th June. The programme will begin again in October. New initiative for NHSE is instead of GP's doing a referral straight away for some conditions, they will 	

	refer to the specialist for advice in the first instance, if the specialist thinks it requires a referral the specialist will convert it to a referral, however in lots of instances advice will come back to the GP to pass on to the patient without the need for a referral. This saves patient time and avoids unnecessary referrals. • Group consultations instead of one to one consultations for certain condition e.g. HRT, Cholesterol. The benefit of this is to save GP time and learning from one another. Currently this is in the planning/training stage.
